CURRICULUM

High school students can choose from an extensive catalog of more than 140 courses. Most courses are offered in multiple versions: core (200 level), comprehensive (300 level), honors and 19 AP® courses. Up to four levels of World Languages and 11 career prep pathways are offered. Eligible students grade 9-12 may enroll in our Dual Enrollment program powered by Acadeum with Baker College, Western Texas College, Southeastern University and Franklin University. Course selections include multiple options of pre-approved core subjects that satisfy school credit requirements for graduation at K12 Private Academy. Additionally, many K12 Private Academy comprehensive, honors and AP® level courses may be used for NCAA athletic eligibility.

GRADING SCALE
